Independent,
non-conformist,
bolshy

‘the greatest of the cloth towns in the West’ (1650); bigger town than Bath
Strong non-conformism: ‘the people here seem more alive than most’ *John Wesley*
Cloth a cottage industry; many weavers, dyers and carders working in their own homes; many were literate and independent-minded
Politically dominated by business people – not the aristocracy
1830s, Industrial Revolution – poverty, death, migration, riots
Singer started an Art School 1865
More recent history - Frome has attracted non-conformists, social and economic entrepreneurs

Micro-enterprises – importance for Frome



- Government investment in manufacturing in Somerset centred on aerospace, nuclear, A303
- Replacement for manufacturing industry are jobs in service industry – tend to be zero hours contracts
- So how do we sustain an economic future for Frome?
- Frome already has 1000 businesses, 72% of which employ 9 people or less ('micros')
 - High-tech, quirky shops, artisans, consultants, architects
 - Some examples of start-ups in last few years: 'Postscript', 'Raggedy', Riverhouse Café, 'Mount Art', 'Moo & Too' & 'Phreaky Gamewear' (started by a former College student & Cheese & Grain apprentice)
 - But also trades people, catering, charities and social enterprises
- What does Frome need to give birth to, support and help grow such enterprises?

What makes an area enterprising?



- 'Buzz'
 - Opportunities to network
 - Positive media coverage
 - Lively entertainment & arts
 - Access to business advice/strong business support networks
 - Access to finance
 - Entrepreneurial public servants
- Easy access to low cost co-working spaces
- Superfast broadband
