2014/001P	1 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION David Taylor asked for an update on the status of the money transferred in the selling of the new Steiner School site. Jane Llewellyn responded that the matter was still in the hands of solicitors. Mr Taylor also asked Cllrs about \$106 monies and whether MDC got a cut where the monies are meant for reimbursement to the Town. Jane Llewellyn stated that this was dependant on the \$106 agreement, all of which can be viewed by the public at MDC Offices. Mr Taylor stated that he did not believe all the monies were accounted for. Cllr Goldfinger responded that MDC now have a \$106 Officer in place to keep track of all agreements. Mr Taylor asked that Cllrs make MDC aware that due to bedroom tax prices, residents of Aster Communities Homes are being forced out of their houses. Jean Lowe asked the Planning & Development Officer if a copy of the Design & Access Statement for the Frontier Application could be displayed down at the library. Gerald Quartley asked Cllrs for an update on Dog Control Orders in the Town — Jane Llewellyn will update at the next meeting. Mr Quartley also stated that the road at Badcox is unsuitable for cyclists due to the bad surface and asked Cllrs to make SCC aware it needs resurfacing. This is to be put on TCR to be followed up. Mr Quartley also thanked Frome Town Council on behalf of the Public Transport Users Group for supporting the funding of the Bristol-Weymouth Line. Margaret Merrill asked Cllrs which application had been approved for the Bennetts Gardens site. This was confirmed and Cllr Sprawson-White informed Cllrs that all housing on the development was to be affordable housing. Cllr Sprawson-White entered at 6.02pm	Action

Elevation drawings were not provided with the plans, poor layout of the buildings, Frome's Neighbourhood Plan requires developments to be neighbourhoods not 'carparks and sheds'. The talk of community space in the design and access statement is not upheld in the design. The housing need snapshot taken by Yarlington does not meet the Mendip Housing Need Survey. FTC needs more clarification on the state of the cycle path and the effects the development would have on it.
