

Master Plan

This plan is the culmination of developing strategic options for an improved Victoria Park.

It shows how the objectives in the accompanying document have been interpreted, combining the design ideas illustrated earlier to create an initial plan for discussion.

It is not a final design, but a tool for developing a plan with the community for the future of Victoria Park. We invite your comments on the ideas shown.

Initial ideas include:

- New path network - better access for people, park maintenance and events vehicles.
- Removal of the pitch & putt fence - gain additional open space for events and a cohesive park.

1) Trees and Gardens

- More trees planted throughout the park.
- New garden areas for resting and watching.
- Central lawn for walking, informal games and holding community events.

2) Buildings and Structures

- New multi-use building.
- Bandstand retained.
- Current café and toilets given new use.
- Bomb shelter and mower store removed.

3) Sports and Games

- Sports facilities concentrated in eastern side of the park.
- Large playing field for team sports.
- Passive activities located in western side of the park.

4) Drainage

- Combination of drainage methods to improve drainage in the south eastern corner.
- Incorporate open ponds and vegetated channels for wildlife into the drainage design.
- Incorporate water play into the drainage design.

5) Events and Performance

- Bandstand retained.
- Flexible seating surrounding bandstand for outdoor performances.
- Large open grass area for local events.
