Summary

The Grants Advisory Group met on the 15 January to consider nine applications for Community Grants. Six of them are recommended for approval as shown in Table 1 below.

The summary of Mayor's Grants and Crowdfunder pledges for this financial year to date follow and are for information.

Community Grants (£300 - £2k)

Following the re-introduction of the Community Grants at Council in October 17 it was agreed that there would be two grant rounds this financial year, with a budget of $\pounds 8491$ for each of the two rounds. The first window closed on 22 December and the next will close on the 15 February.

The Grants Advisory group met on the 15 January to consider nine applications submitted in the first window. Bids are assessed through a scoring system by Cllrs on the grants advisory panel, who then meet to discuss and agree recommendations for Council approval. The table below are the grants proposed by the panel for approval.
