Summary

The Grants Advisory Group met on the 26^{th} February to consider nine applications for Community Grants. Six of them are recommended for approval as shown in Table 1 below.

Community Grants (£300 - £2k)

Following the re-introduction of the Community Grants at Council in October 2017 it was agreed that there would be two grant rounds this financial year, with a budget of £8491 for each of the two rounds.

The Grants Advisory Panel met on the 26 February to consider seven applications submitted in this second, and final, window. Bids are assessed through a scoring system by Cllrs on the panel, who then meet to discuss and agree recommendations for Council approval. The table below are the grants proposed by the panel for approval.
