For decision – The Management & Improvement Plan for the Old Showfield Author: Chris Stringer, Environment Manager

## Summary

This report presents the new (updated) Management & Improvement Plan for the Old Showfield.

This plan will replace the previous plan, which was discussed and approved by the Council Matters committee in February 2018.

The new plan is scheduled to be reviewed in another year's time (early spring 2020)

## Background

We have plans for the management and improvement of all the parks and green spaces that we look after. These plans are discussed and then formally approved by the Council Matters committee. Depending on a number of factors, the plans are then reviewed every year, every 18 months, or every other year.

By design, the format of our plans is repeated across all the parks and green spaces that we look after. The plans include important details like the main habitat typology and a management summary.

The plans aren't intended to be daunting or overly technical. Rather, we hope that our plans are straightforward, informative and engaging, and that they make people want to head outdoors to explore the town's parks and green spaces.

## Previously

The old (outgoing) plan for the Old Showfield was discussed and approved by the Council Matters Committee in February 2018.

The new plan is at Appendix 6.1.

### Next steps

Our plans are often ambitious, and this means that we don't always manage to deliver all of the next steps within the review schedule of the plan.

With reference to the old plan, the following table identifies what we've done at the Showfield in the last year. It also identifies the things that we haven't managed to do just yet.

# February 2018 to February 2019:

We still want to do all the things that we set out to do in 2018 - so these next steps have been carried over to the new plan. (We're always thinking about new events for the spaces that we look after - so this will continue to happen. But it isn't stated on the plan anymore.)

Alongside the aims that we're carrying over, we've added two more next steps.

February 2019 to February 2020:
