For decision - Community Grants £300 - £2,000

Summary

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) met on 9 October 2019 to consider five applications for round two of the Community Grants. All five of them are recommended for approval as shown in Table 1 below.

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) is made up of interested councillors and primarily meets to review community grant applications three times per year. The group recommends distribution of grant funding, through the administration of an application process, to Town Matters Committee. The group also reviews the processes used for grants. Proposals for a revised grants system for 2020 onwards will be brought to the next Council meeting on 20 November.

1. Community Grants (£300 - £2,000) – for approval

There are three grant rounds in this financial year with a total budget of £25,000, split roughly equally between each round. Bids are assessed by the GAP Cllrs in advance, using a scoring system. They then meet to discuss and agree recommendations, which then come to the Town Matters Committee for approval.

The Grants Advisory Panel met on 1 October to consider five applications submitted in this grant window, totalling £6,900.

Table 1 shows the grants proposed by the Panel for approval.
