For decision – Substantial Project Fund up to £8,000

Summary

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) met on 4 February 2020 to consider twelve applications for the very first Substantial Project Fund application year. Ten of them are recommended for approval as shown in Table 1 below.

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) is made up of interested councillors and primarily meets to review community grant applications three times per year. The group recommends distribution of grant funding, through the administration of an application process, to Town Matters Committee.

This Substantial Project Fund was launched in October 2019. Organisations are able to apply for funding up to £8,000. The total funding available for this grant was £50k. In total we received twelve applications totalling £87,731.

Table 1 shows the grants proposed by the Panel for approval.
