TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE BY VEHICLES (ROAD CLOSURE)

Elm Lane in the Parish of Great Elm

5 DAY NOTICE

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under section 14(2) of the Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, will introduce a temporary prohibition of use by vehicles (road closure) on the lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice.

This Notice is required for Bristol Water to locate a buried Stop Tap on or near the road listed in Schedule 1. The restrictions may not be effected for the whole of the period but it is anticipated that the road will be restricted as and when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessary to execute the works for a period not exceeding five days;

The works are anticipated to be operative from 1st March 2021 to 2nd March 2021 for 2 days between the hours of 00:00 - 23:59.
