#### For ratification – Substantial grants

### Summary

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) met on 12 July 2021 to consider twelve applications for the first round of the Substantial Grants for 2021/22. Ten applications are recommended for ratification as shown in Table 1 below.

Also included is a summary of Mayor's Grants awarded since the last report at the Town Matters meeting on 16 June 2021.

There is a total budget of £55k for Substantial Grants for the year 2021/22. Organisations could apply for between £5k – £6k. However, the panel will consider applications for up to £10k in exceptional circumstances. All applications are assessed by the GAP Cllrs using a scoring system. They then meet to discuss the applications in detail and, informed by the scoring matrix, agree recommendations. For the very first time the applicants were invited to attend this meeting. They were given the opportunity to hear the discussion between Cllrs and also provided an opportunity to answer questions the panel had. Cllrs and applicants agreed that this worked well, and they would like to continue this into the future. With further covid restrictions lifting it would be hoped to invite members of the public to attend the meetings as well.

As agreed at the Council meeting on 17 March 2021, the decision to approve the recommendations from GAP was delegated to the Town Clerk who has approved the grants as detailed in the table below. Therefore, the table below is for ratification.
