Notice is hereby given that on 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 2021 Somerset County Council made the above Order in exercise of the provisions of Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as previously advertised on the 5<sup>th</sup> August 2021, to introduce temporary traffic restrictions in the roads specified in the Schedules below.

The works are expected to commence on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2021 until 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 2021 (between the hours of 21:00 and 06:00) and the restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

**Statement of reasons for making the Order**
