Temporary Closure of Elm Lane To Hapsford Hill, Elm Lane To Park Hill and Elm Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Elm Lane to Hapsford Hill - from the junction with Park Hill to the junction with Elm Lane, south westwards for distance of 210 metres.

Elm Lane to Park Hill - from the junction with Elm Lane, westwards for a distance of 320 metres.

Elm Lane - from the junction with Elm Lane to Hapsford Hill, south eastwards for a distance of 250 metres

A total distance of 780 metres..

This Order will enable **BT Openreach to carry out overhead and underground cabling works**

The Order becomes effective on 2nd September 2021 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **7th September 2021** and last until **24th September 2021** between the hours of **(09:30 - 15:30)** for a total of **18 days**.
