## Somerset County Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2) (21 Day Notice) Footway Between Beverley Close And Critchill Road (F1056/640), Frome Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along

Footway Between Beverley Close And Critchill Road - from the junction with Beverley Close, southwestwards to the junction with Critchill Road, for a distance of 40 metres.

This Notice will come into operation on the 2nd November 2021 and will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period Somerset County Council may issue a further 21 day Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

There is no alternative route for this closure. The works promoter will contact residents and businesses directly to discuss access arrangements.

Please note that should you require to view a closure which is more than two weeks ahead, you will need to register for free with One.Network.
