Temporary Closure of Innox Hill

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Innox Hill - from the junction with Innox Hill, northwards for a distance of 40 metres

This Order will enable **BT Openreach safe access to underground BT structures**

The Order becomes effective on 03rd March 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **7th March 2022** and last until **7th March 2022** between the hours of **08:00 - 15:30** for a total of **8 hours**.

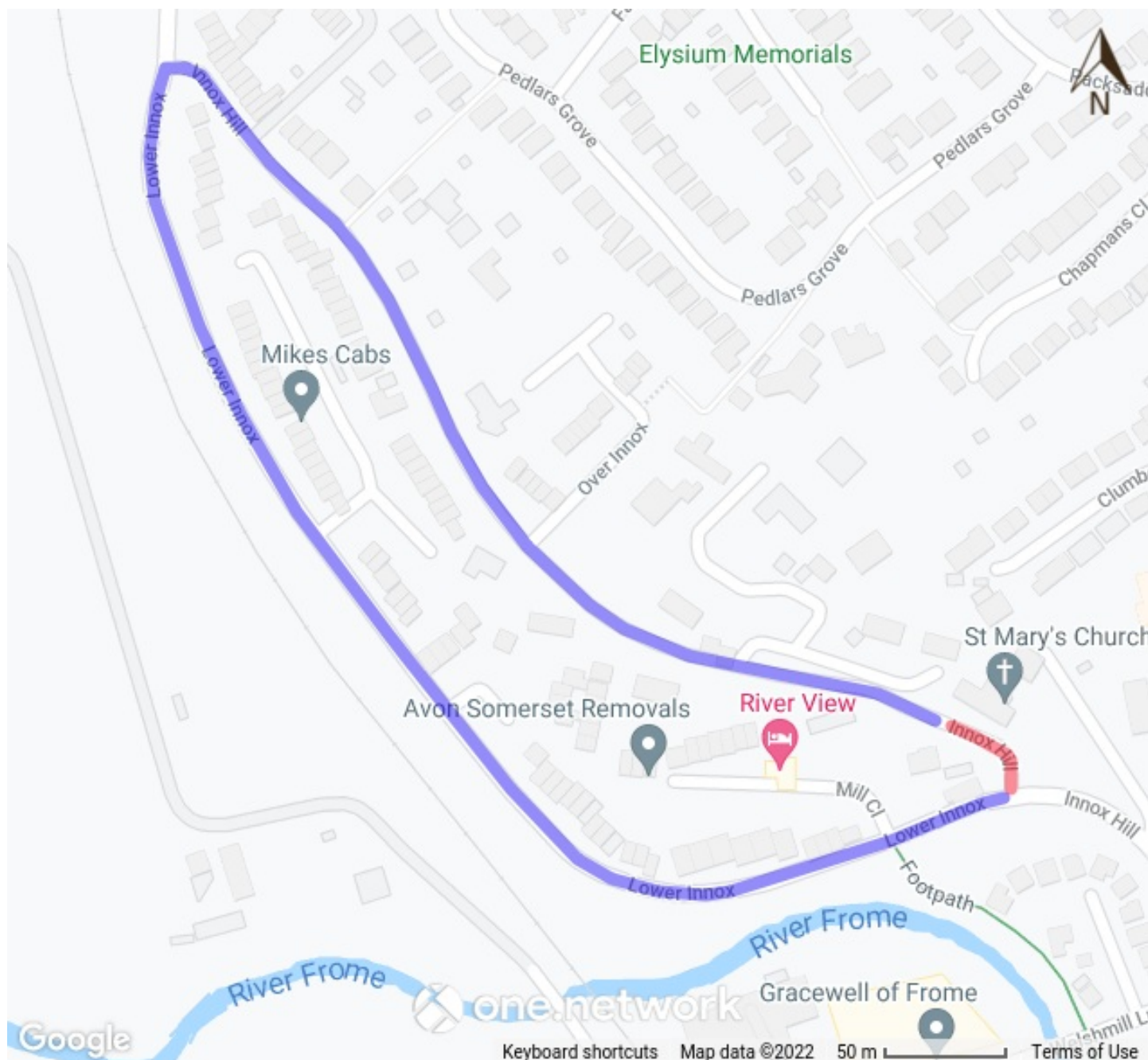
