Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles
(Exemption for Buses only)

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is to introduce temporary prohibition of vehicles on the lengths of road listed in the Schedule to this Notice.

This Notice will come into operation on the 21st day of May 2022 between 10:00 hours and 16:00 hours to accommodate the Flash Forest Green Breather Day Event on the 21st May 2022 and will remain in force for a maximum of 5 days. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.
