Temporary Closure of Buckland Lane

Somerset County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, have made an Order prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along;

Buckland Lane - from the junction with Elm Lane, southwards for a distance of 100 metres.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out new supply works.**

The Order becomes effective on 9th June 2022 and will remain in force for eighteen months. The works are expected to commence on **13th June 2022** and last until **17th June 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **5 days**.

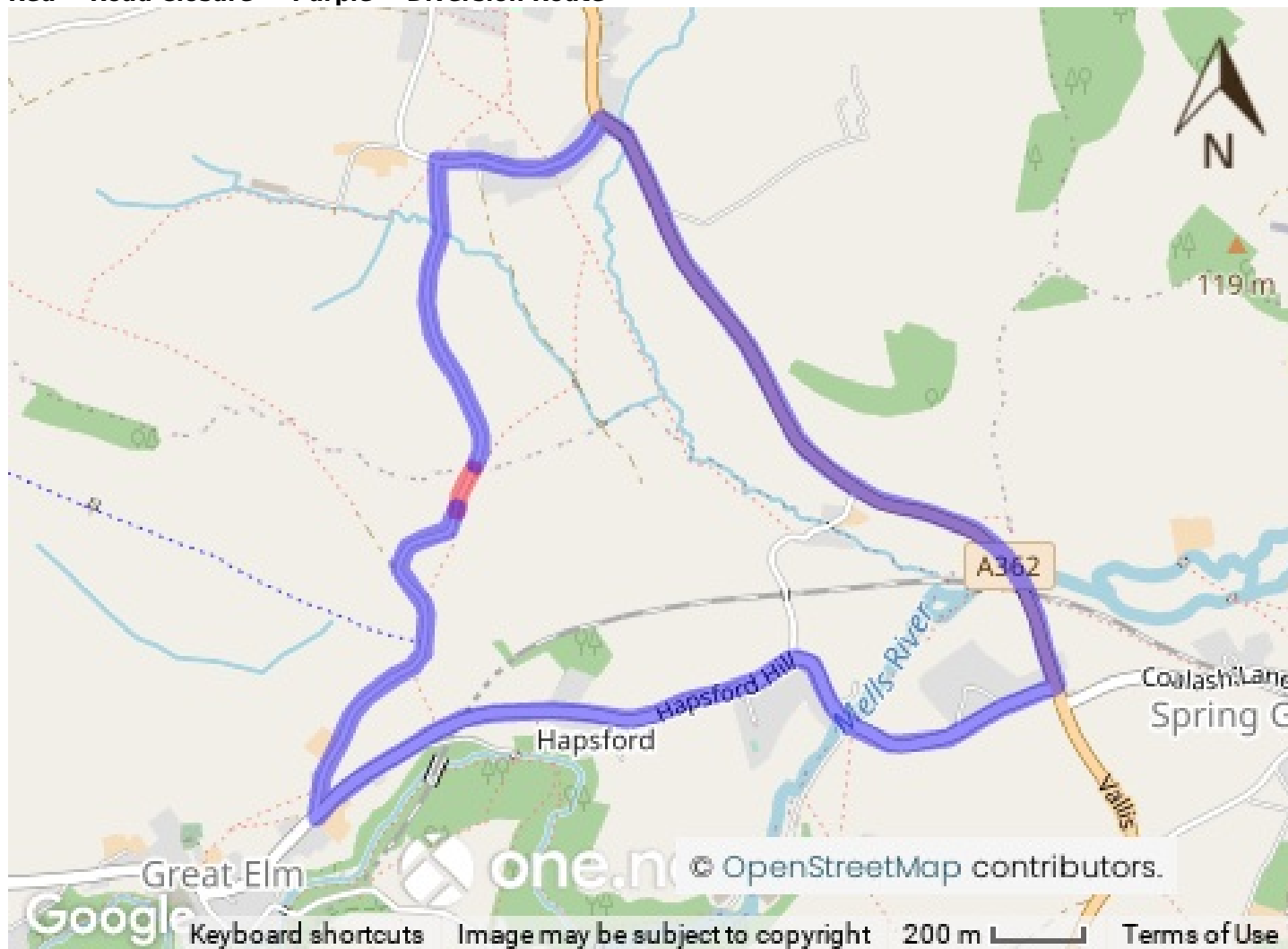
