What you'll find here already

- A fenced play area with a mix of swings, slides and climbing frames
 good for toddlers
- · Grass for running about; rolling; playing and generally having fun
- A cut-through off (old) Rodden Road; looked after by the residents of Hillside Drive
- A boundary hedge for birds, bugs and other wildlife and a backdrop of mature trees
- Establishing trees planted to add to the landscape and provide shade in the play area
