Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2)
(5 Day Notice)
Coalash Lane Mells River Access Road, Selwood
Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along

Coalash Lane Mells River Access Road - from the junction with Coalash Lane, northwards for a distance of 440 metres.

This Notice will come into operation on the **8th August 2022** and will remain in force for a maximum of 5 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period then Somerset County Council may make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 Act, to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **8th August 2022** and last until **10th August 2022** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **3 days**.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out works to replace leaking stop tap.**

There is no alternative route for this closure. The works promoter will contact residents and business directly to discuss access arrangements.

Please note that should you require to view a closure which is more than two weeks ahead, you will need to register for free with One.Network.
