For ratification – Community Grants

Summary

The Grants Advisory Panel (GAP) met on 4 October 2022 to consider eleven applications for the second round of the Community Grants for 2022/23. Nine applications were proposed for approval. The Town Clerk approved them, and it is recommended that Council ratifies this decision. The nine applications are in table 1 below.

1. Community grants

There was £45,813 remaining in the budget. It was agreed to allocate around half of this to allow a third round in 2023. All applications are assessed by the GAP Cllrs using a scoring system. They then meet to discuss the applications in detail and, informed by the scoring matrix, agree recommendations. The Town Clerk has approved these decisions and therefore, the table below, is for ratification. A third round for applications will close on 20^{th} February 2023 at 5pm.
