## The Balance Sheet

The Balance Sheet can be viewed on the website here at Appendix 5.4. It is a breakdown of assets and liabilities as at 31 January 2023.

## Assets

Our assets are money in our bank accounts, money we have invested, and money owed to us. The first part of the Balance Sheet lists these assets including short term investments of cash on deposit, totalling  $\pounds_{1,531,160}$ .

The cash balances at 31 January 2023 are shown on the Balance Sheet:

### Liabilities

Our liabilities are money that we owed at 31 January 2023.

- £15,694 Trade creditors
- £203 Known staff deductions
- £352 Mayor's Charity

Total net assets (assets minus liabilities) at 31 January are £1,514,912. Comprising £773,818 for budgeted expenditure, £180,000 for the prudent General Reserve and £561,094 in Earmarked Reserves (EMRs) for specific, previously planned projects and purposes, The list of current EMRs is the last half of the Balance Sheet.

Actual v Budget overview – period ending 31 January 2023 (83% through year) There are some over and underspends showing in the '% spent' column of the Income & Expenditure report but overall actual expenditure to year end March 2023 is currently estimated to be on budget.

## Card payment processing

Zettle our previous card payment processing facility (mostly used at Discover Frome) was recently taken over by Paypal. Paypal's Internal Auditors found that Zettle were not allowed to provide accounts to Councils now they are managed by Paypal but we have been unable to obtain an explanation. Consequently, we have not been able to process card payments at the Town Hall or Discover Frome Information Point since 9 January 2023.

We have been looking into alternative options and contacted various other Town Councils to see what systems they use for their card payments. One option was with Barclaycard but this required hard credit checks on individuals which we don't think is appropriate as this is for work purposes and will stay on the individual's credit history for some time. We also looked at EPOS, however with the monthly fee of £80 for two card payment terminals this wouldn't be viable. Wetherby Parish Council use Sum Up, which has no monthly fee. There is one-off payment of £39 per card reader, then 1.69% per transaction.

To enable us to take card payments we are in the process of setting up two Sum Up accounts for Frome Town Council; one under Sarah Williams name for the Town Hall and the other under Rachel Griffin for the Discover Frome Information Point. Sum Up has the same stock and inventory function as Zettle which automatically update stock levels after sales. Having two different accounts means that the stock for the Town Hall and Discover Frome Information Point can be reported on separately, and stock levels will be accurate for the location.

### Conclusion

FTC remains financially sound with adequate funds and assets.
