The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **7th March 2023** and last until **9th March 2023** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **3 days**.

This Order will enable Bristol Water to carry out works to connect to the water main.
