

**Somerset County Council**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(2)**  
**(21 Day Notice)**  
**Long Ground, Frome**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles**

Somerset County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and after giving notice to the Chief Officer of Police, has issued a Notice, the effect of which is prohibiting all traffic from proceeding along

**Long Ground - from the junction with New Buildings, northwards for a total distance of 35 metres.**

This Notice will come into operation on the **28th March 2023** and will remain in force for a maximum of 21 days. If the works cannot be completed during that period Somerset County Council may issue a further 21 day Notice under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or make a temporary Order under Section 14(1) of that Act to continue in force the provisions of this Notice for a further period. The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **28th March 2023** and last until **3rd April 2023** between the hours of **00:00 - 23:59** for a total of **7 days**.

This Order will enable **Scottish & Southern Electricity Networks to carry out cable fault repair.**
