The restrictions will only apply when indicated by traffic signs.

The works are expected to commence on **3rd May 2023** and last until **5th May 2023** between the hours of **00:00** - **23:59** for a total of **3 days**.

This Order will enable **Bristol Water to carry out works to add new connection.**
