For information - Review of Nurture Open Spaces Work Programme

The work programme is on track – see table below. Key highlights:

- Henley Way Steps have been installed, connecting footpath and surrounding area enhanced, improvements made to path on Welshmill side, Plan for better signage
- Mary Baily following adoption of management plans a range of improvements have taken place including: zip wire, codesign project commissioned, skatepark proposal adopted at council, pocket meadows planting, new service tap for watering installed
- Victoria Park: sail shade in toddler play area, tender of respray of mower shed mural, carving of large trunk into sculpture bench and table, table tennis table, makeover to 'Poland' corner (including new flowerbed)
- Broadway Pond works finished (though liner has puncture). Plans for compost toilet installation
- Boyle's Cross Fountain re-lined
- Town Centre Street Sweeper now fully operational, planters make-over, library bench replaced
- Devolution FTC is now managing all the agreed sites for devolution. Legal transfer is imminent
- Work to set up St John's community project
- 2nd Grillo (ride on mower) is bought and operational
- Proposal for compact tractor brought to this committee
- Depot is now fully operational with all remedial works needed for year 1 complete and new roller shutter doors, secure pedestrian door and alarms.
- Ranger base has been made secure including a major overhaul of doors, locks. Last phase is improvements to alarms
- Adderwell has now been bought, management plan brought to this meeting for adoption, access works started and work on invasive plants undertaken. Drafty management plan produced.
- Community Woodland Horses removed, land made secure and advanced planning for October reseeding from 27 Oct (by horse) and March tree planting
- Nature Recovery Plan workshops and community engagement has been undertaken.

- Wild about trees review 1,071 trees planted in 24/25
